INTERSTATE IMPORT HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

BOVINE BRUCELLOSIS REQUIREMENTS: (includes Bison)

Brucellosis Free States:

A. Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) and individual ID (USDA approved metal eartag, registry brand or registry tattoo) required except on steers, spayed heifers and slaughter cattle coming directly from a farm. Slaughter cattle originating from sale barns are required to have a CVI and individual identification. For cattle consigned to petting zoos, see PETTING ZOO REQUIREMENTS.

B. No brucellosis test requirements for cattle originating from Brucellosis Free states

C. No Entry Permit Required.

Brucellosis Class A States and states that have been Brucellosis Free less than 24 months Idaho, Montana, Texas and Wyoming

A. **Permit**, Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) and individual ID (USDA approved metal eartag, registry brand or registry tattoo) required except on steers, spayed heifers and slaughter cattle. For cattle consigned to petting zoos, see PETTING ZOO REQUIREMENTS.

B. **Female cattle of dairy breeds 4 months of age or older must satisfy one of the following:**

1. Be an official brucellosis calfhooD vaccinate and have a negative brucellosis test within 30 days of shipment if 18 months of age and older, **OR**

2. Originate from a brucellosis certified herd. Certified herd number and date of last complete herd test must be documented on the CVI, **OR**

3. Originate directly from the farm of a bona fide dairy herd in a brucellosis free state (include statement of origin on CVI) and have a negative brucellosis test within 30 days of shipment if 18 months of age or older

C. **Dairy bulls** must have a negative brucellosis test within 30 days of shipment if 18 months of age or older.

D. **Beef cattle** will require a negative brucellosis test within 30 days of shipment if 18 months of age older regardless of calfhooD vaccination status.

BOVINE TUBERCULOSIS REQUIREMENTS: (includes Bison)

A. From TB Free States:

1. Must originate from an accredited herd, or
2. Have a negative test within 60 days if 6 months or older.
 3. EXCEPTION: BEEF cattle native to and originating from a TB free state may enter without test (include statement of origin on CVI).

B. From TB Modified Accredited States (California, Michigan, New Mexico & Minnesota)

1. Must originate from an accredited herd, or
2. Have a negative test within 60 days if 6 months or older.

C. Mexican Cattle:

1. Must have a negative test within 60 days of shipment regardless of age or sex.
2. Steers must be "M" branded.
