### Health Requirements Governing the Admission of Animals as of February 15, 2007

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All cattle exhibiting at the National Junior Angus Show, <u>including those from Oklahoma</u>, are required to have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) with USDA approved individual identification, breed, age, and sex of animal.

### **Beef Cattle Import Regulations**

Steers – All States: No test requirements + CVI (w/i 30 days + individual ID by official eartag)
Breeding/Exhibition – Under 18 months of age – All States: No test requirements + CVI (w/i 30 + individual ID by official eartag)

Texas and Idaho origin – 2A

New Mexico (Curry/Roosevelt counties only) - 2B

New Mexico (all counties except Curry/Roosevelt) – 2C

Michigan (some counties) – 2B

Michigan (some counties) – 2C

Minnesota - 2B

All other states - 2C

Cattle that test positive for TB or cattle from herds quarantined for TB shall not enter Oklahoma

### 2A – Texas and Idaho origin (Brucellosis Class A & TB Free state)

18 months and older/sexually intact: CVI (w/i 30 days of entry + individual ID by official eartag + test results) Originate from a Brucellosis Free Herd (Herd Certification Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI) **OR** Negative Brucellosis test within 30 days prior to entry (Brucellosis vaccinated heifers test at 24 months old)

# **2B - Michigan (some counties only),** (Brucellosis Free & TB Modified Accredited states)

## Minnesota, or New Mexico (Curry and Roosevelt counties only),

18 months and older/sexually intact: CVI (w/i 30 days of entry + individual ID by official eartag + test results) Originate from a Tuberculosis Free Herd (Herd Accreditation Number and Date of last Herd Test on CVI)  $\mathbf{OR}$  Negative TB test within 60 days prior to entry

### **2C - All other States** (Brucellosis and TB Free states)

Spayed heifers/steers/heifers less than 18 months of age: Feeding/Grazing/Roping – large truck loads – No test requirements + CVI (w/i 30 days) + individual ID not required

Breeding/Exhibition – Under 18 months of age: No test requirements + CVI (w/i 30 + individual ID by official eartag)

18 months and older: No test requirements + CVI (w/i 30 days of entry + individual ID by official eartag)

# More concise wording:

**ALL** cattle present at the National Junior Angus Show shall meet the following requirements:

- 1) All cattle assigned from out of state must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection with USDA approved individual identification, breed, age, and sex of animal.
- 2) Brucellosis Negative test within 30 days for sexually intact animals over 18 months of age except official vaccinates of beef breeds under 24 months of age, animals from Brucellosis free states, **OR** Certified Herd Number and date of last herd test.
- 3) Tuberculosis Negative test within 60 days for sexually intact <u>BEEF CATTLE</u> 18 months of age and older from Minnesota, Michigan, and Roosevelt and Curry Counties in New Mexico **OR** Accredited Herd Number and date of last herd test.

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
