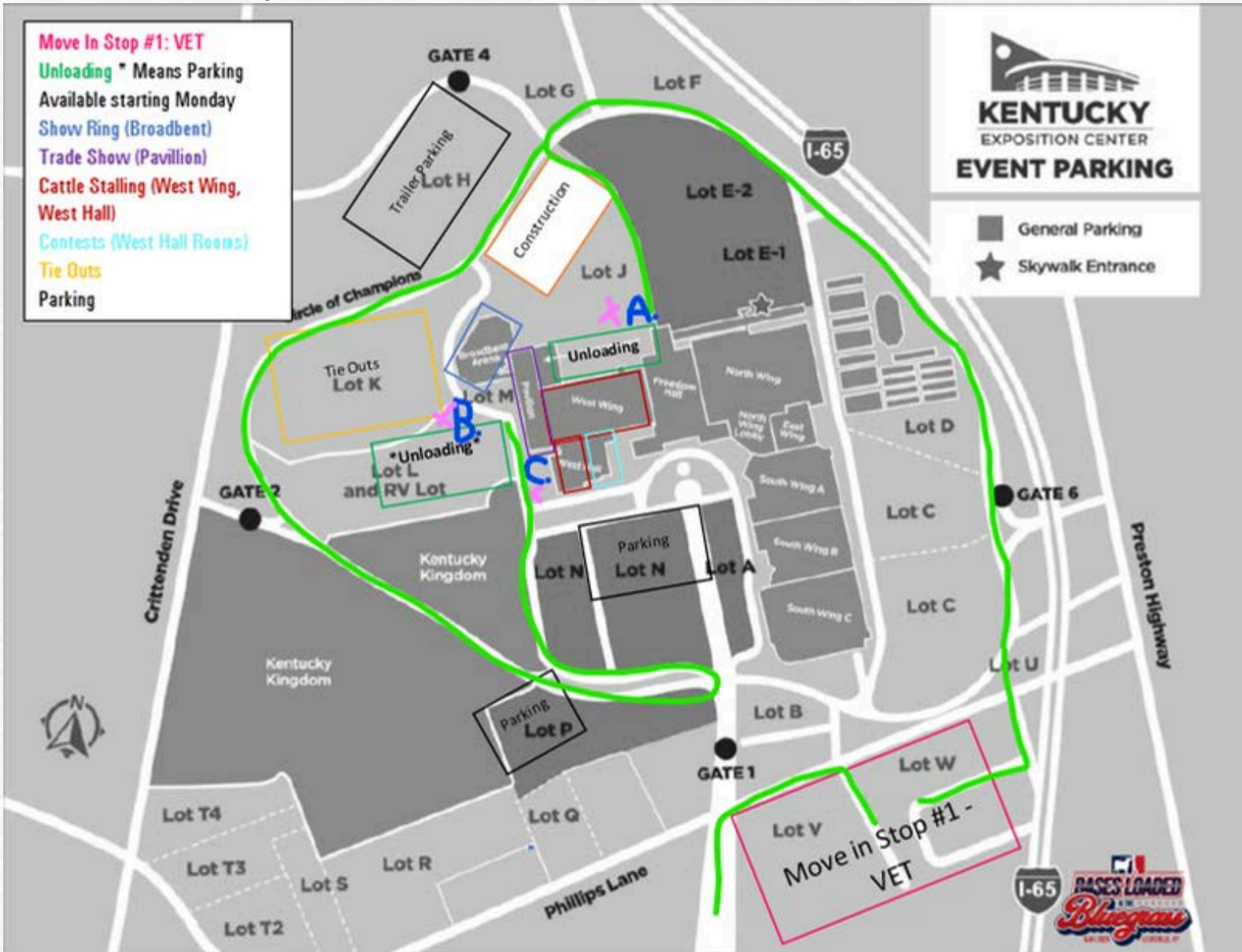
CLOSURE DATE: JUNE 1-JULY 31, 2026

DETOURS: I-65 TRAFFIC WILL BE DETOURED USING I-264 (WATTERSON EXPRESSWAY) AND INTERSTATE 64. ALSO, THE RAMPS AT JEFFERSON STREET AND LIBERTY STREET/MUHAMMAD ALI BOULEVARD WILL REMAIN OPEN FOR SIDE-ROAD TRAFFIC THROUGH DOWNTOWN.

ARRIVAL: OUT OF STATE CATTLE SHOULD NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 2 P.M. ON SATURDAY, JULY 11TH. YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO SETUP IN BARNS UNTIL 2 P.M. ANY OUT OF STATE TRAVELERS ARRIVING PRIOR TO SUNDAY MORNING WILL BE DIRECTED TO TIE OUTS. NO OUT OF STATE CATTLE PERMITTED INTO THE BARNS UNTIL SUNDAY AT 6:00 A.M.

ENTRANCE AND TRAILER PARKING: ALL TRAILERS (INCLUDING SEMIS) WILL BE REQUIRED TO ENTER LOT V TO HAVE HEALTH PAPERS CHECKED. ONCE GIVEN A VET VERIFICATION SLIP YOU WILL FOLLOW THE GREEN LINE TO ONE OF THE PINK X'S TO UNLOAD YOUR CATTLE AND TACK DEPENDING WHERE YOU ARE STALLED. ALL TRAILERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO PARK IN THE DESIGNATED TRAILER PARKING AREA ON THE GROUNDS AFTER THEY ARE UNLOADED.

STALLING INFO



BARN STALLS

The panels in the barns are wood. Some rows will be the red panels that are from tie outs. You cannot paint any of these panels. We will stall in the West Wing and West Hall.



TIE-OUTS

Tie-outs will be available on Saturday, July 11th. PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 2 P.M. Tie-outs will be assigned by state unless in the Trailer Tie-outs. If cattle arrive on Saturday evening, they must remain in tie-outs.



For cow-calf pair pens, a designated row will be available. The first 25 cow-calf pair pens in tie outs will be complete pens. Meaning, no additional panels will be needed for pens in that designated row for cow/calf pair pens. Keep in mind, those are first come first serve.

GENERATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED FOR THE BARN

Kentucky's Facility rules with construction and building fire permits do **NOT ALLOW** generators.

THINGS NOT ALLOWED IN TRADITIONAL TIE-OUTS

- Portacools
- Farms signs
- Butt or aisle signs
- Generators
- Straw in tieouts

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Livestock exhibiting signs of any infectious, contagious, or communicable disease such as, but not limited to, warts, ringworm, pinkeye, or foot rot ARE NOT ELIGIBLE for exhibitors and will be refused entry.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL CATTLE IMPORTED INTO KENTUCKY:

Any animal demonstrating clinical signs of NWS infestation are prohibited from entry into Kentucky.

- 1) Certificate of Veterinarian Inspection or Health Certificate within 30 days of time of entry.
- 2) Official Identification required. This includes 840 series electronic tag, NUES tag, registration tattoo with paper.
- 3) Import Permits are required for ALL cattle from **Michigan**.

Modified Accredited Area (Alcona/Alpena/Montmorency/Oscoda): Whole herd TB test on all animals 12 months of age and older within 1 year of movement & incoming animal(s) 2 months of age and older tested w/in 60 days of entry, unless originating from an Accredited Herd.

New World Screwworm Protocols for all cattle from infested states:

- Kentucky permit number obtained from the Kentucky Office of State Veterinarian (OSV)
- CVI Issued within 72 hours prior to entry into Kentucky
- Signed statement from an Accredited Veterinarian (AV) attesting: "I have inspected the animals included in this shipment and have found them free of clinical signs of NWS myasis", or state of origin pre-movement inspection forms filled and signed if available. (must accompany movement)
- Notation of any treatments given to the animals on this shipment for NWS.
- Signed statement/form obtained within 24 hours after entry into Kentucky attesting that animals were inspected by: private Kentucky AV or authorized designee, Kentucky OSV personnel, or Kentucky USDA VS personnel and were found free of NWS.
- All non-Equine livestock must have Official ID (e.g.- RFID, OID). Equine movements must be accompanied by valid EIA

DOMESTIC PET MOVEMENTS FROM INFESTED STATES ARE ENCOURAGED TO FOLLOW THE SAME GUIDELINES

With most health papers electronic, we ask that you upload a copy of your health papers for the National Junior Angus Show through AAA Login > Programs > NJAA by Thursday, July 9th. The uploaded copy counts as the additional copy requested.

FEED & BEDDING

The barns and tie outs will be pre-bedded prior to your arrival. The bedding is bark. Exhibitors will be allowed to add their own if they would like.

CODE OF CONDUCT

The Code of Conduct is now included in all NJAA-sanctioned event entries. You will be required to agree to the terms before completing checkout. By accepting the Code of Conduct during entry, your acknowledgment serves as your signature. No paper copies are required to be submitted to the Events and Junior Activities Department.

BQA / YQCA REQUIREMENT

Beef Quality Assurance (BQA) or a youth equivalent is required to compete at the National Junior Angus Show for ALL NJAS exhibitors. Certificates can be uploaded through AAA Login similar to the health paper!

If you haven't been certified YQCA codes are still available. Contact events@angus.org to get your free code!
