Health requirements for show cattle:

- From all states with exceptions in Michigan, a CVI and individual ID by official USDA ear tag is required.
- For cattle coming from Alcona, Alpena, Montmorency and Oscoda counties in Michigan, a permit is required, along with CVI, individual ID by official USDA ear tag and a negative TB test within 60 days of entry.

CVIs should be received within 30 days of entry. There should be only one state of destination on the CVI; however, there may be more than one destination city within the same state on a single CVI.

Recognized individual identification includes official USDA ear tags, registered tattoos or registered brands (with a copy of registration papers accompanying animal).
